



## **ELECTRONIC MEETING DETERMINATION**

In accordance with the Open Meetings Act, it is hereby determined that in-person meetings of the City Council, and the City's subsidiary bodies, is not practical or prudent at this time due to the COVID-19 pandemic as outlined in Governor Pritzker's Disaster Proclamation issued on January 7, 2022, and pursuant to continued elevated cases of COVID-19 in the community, coupled with high hospitalization rates.

In addition, it is determined that not more than 10 members of the public shall be permitted to physically attend said meetings due to the increased risk of transmission of COVID-19 indoors. In light of the limited attendance, the City will provide alternative methods for the public to attend and participate in its meetings, including by providing public comment at its meetings via Zoom and submitting public comment via email.

This Determination shall be effective for all meetings after execution and through February 28, 2022, unless revoked sooner by the Mayor and contingent upon Governor Pritzker renewing his Disaster Proclamation.
