Shots Fired

Bloomington, IL - On Sunday, 2/02/25, at approximately 1:12 a.m., Bloomington police officers were dispatched to the 300 block of Valley View Circle. Several callers reported hearing shot(s) being fired in the area. Patrol officers arrived on scene and conducted additional follow-up investigation to confirm a shot(s) fired incident had occurred.

No injuries have been reported at this time. There was property damage reported as a result of this incident.

Chief Jamal Simington stated, "BPD detectives are working diligently with the community to identify the offender(s) in this concerning act of violence. It was determined at this time, no one was physically harmed, but the feeling of safety for those nearby residence was negatively impacted. I encourage our residents who may have some information about this matter to contact our detectives."
