## *The Bloomington Police Department announces Super Bowl weekend enforcement results*

Bloomington, IL - The Bloomington Police Department today announced their officers made five DUI arrests during Super Bowl weekend. The recent enforcement campaign resulted in three additional arrests, two for drug offenses and one for a sex offender in violation of their registration requirements. Officers working the enforcement campaign took additional action by issuing citations for the following:

Seat belts (4)  
Child restraint (3)  
Speeding (18)  
Distracted driving (7)  
Other (26)

The Super Bowl weekend "Drive Sober or Get Pulled Over" and "Click It or Ticket" enforcement effort ran from Friday, Feb. 7, through the early morning hours of Monday, Feb. 10. The goal was to keep impaired drivers off the roads and ensure more people buckle up and follow all traffic laws.

The recent law enforcement campaign was made possible by federal highway safety funds administered by the Illinois Department of Transportation as part of the statewide "Drive Sober or Get Pulled Over" and "Click It or Ticket" campaigns.
