## *Residence Struck by Gunfire in Tuesday Morning Shots Fired Incident*

Bloomington, IL - On Tuesday, 4/15/25, at 5:51 a.m., Bloomington police officers were dispatched to the 1400 block of North Lee Street. Several callers reported hearing shot(s) being fired in the area. Patrol officers arrived on scene and conducted additional follow-up investigation to confirm a shot(s) fired incident had occurred.

No injuries have been reported at this time. There was property damage to a nearby residence that was struck by gunfire.

Chief Jamal Simington stated, "Our community is fortunate no one was injured during this dangerous incident. Our team is working diligently to solve this incident, and we are requesting your help in the process. If you have any information, please take a moment and notify our detectives or use Tip 411 to report it anonymously. By working together, we can ensure a positive outcome."
