Child Pornography Arrest

Bloomington, IL - On Monday, 6/23/25, after an investigation by the Bloomington Police Department's (BPD) Cyber Crimes Unit, Collin Maguire was arrested on 20 counts of various sexually related offenses. The investigation began when a technology company made a report, to the National Center for Missing and Exploited Children, regarding the uploading and sharing of videos believed to be child sex abuse material.

Detectives with the BPD Criminal Investigations Division executed several search warrants related to the case. Evidence of child sex abuse material (CSAM) and computer-generated child pornography were located. A warrant was later issued for Maguire's arrest. Maguire was served with the arrest warrant at the Franklin County Detention Facility (IL), where he is currently being held on charges related to a different incident.

ARRESTED: Collin P. Maguire, 21, of Normal Illinois

- Possession of child pornography / moving depiction (8 counts)
- Reproduction of child pornography / moving depiction (3 counts)
- Possession of Child Pornography with a victim less than 13 (3 counts)
- Obscene depiction of a purported child (6 counts)

The BPD participates in the Illinois Internet Crimes Against Children (ICAC) Task Force that investigates child exploitation crimes and trains law enforcement agencies. BPD receives CyberTips, or online reports of child pornography, from the National Center for Missing and Exploited Children (NCMEC). The BPD will continue their efforts in investigating cases of child sexual exploitation occurring over the internet. If you believe you or someone you know is a victim of sexual exploitation, you can submit a tip with NCMEC at <https://report.cybertip.org/>.

All suspects are presumed innocent unless proven guilty in the court of law.
