Child Pornography Conviction Nets 140 Years in Prison

Bloomington, IL - On Monday, November 3, 2025, David Breeden was sentenced to 140 years in the Illinois Department of Corrections following a child pornography investigation.

On February 3, 2025, after an investigation by the Bloomington Police Department's (BPD) Cyber Crimes Unit, Breeden was arrested on nine counts of various child pornography offenses. The investigation began when a technology company made a report to the Internet Crimes Against Children (ICAC) Task Force regarding the sharing of child sex abuse material.

Detectives with the BPD Criminal Investigations Division executed several search warrants related to the case. Evidence of Breeden producing child pornography was located. A warrant was issued for Breeden's arrest. Members of the BPD Street Crimes Unit and U.S. Marshals located and arrested Breeden without incident.

In July 2025, Breeden pleaded guilty to six counts of child pornography. On Monday, he was sentenced to a total of 140 years in prison. All six counts are to be served consecutively. Breeden will be eligible for parole in the year 2095.
