The Bloomington Police Department Announces Super Bowl Weekend Enforcement Results

Bloomington, IL - The Bloomington Police Department today announced it made two DUI arrests and issued 15 seat belt citations during the recent Super Bowl enforcement campaign. Officers also issued 35 citations for speeding, 9 for distracted driving, and 22 for other offenses.

“Motorists should understand that we are serious about cracking down on impaired drivers and seat belt and other traffic safety law violators. We do it to save lives,” said Chief Jamal Simington. “Whether it’s alcohol, cannabis or other drugs, impaired driving puts everyone at risk.”

The Super Bowl weekend “Drive Sober or Get Pulled Over” and “Click It or Ticket” enforcement effort ran from Friday, Feb. 6, through the early morning hours of Monday, Feb. 9. The goal was to keep impaired drivers off the roads and ensure more people buckle up and follow all traffic laws.

The law enforcement campaign was made possible by federal highway safety funds administered by the Illinois Department of Transportation.
